Just a few reminders-

- A successful grazing management kickoff workshop provided by Livestock Extension Agent from the state of Hawaii was held January 16, 2026, at the Kailapa pavilion. Mahalo for all those who participated. Follow up workshop will be held February. It will be a 2-day workshop. Exact date and registration link will be sent out soon.
- High Road Solutions will be doing a yearly fire mitigation DRONE flight through Kailapa starting next week.
- KCA Board of directors' nominations are closed. Elections are to follow. KCA board will need to fill the secretary and treasurer seats. Nominees will be sent out in the next week, and elections will follow.

As in previous years, nominees will be contacted and a brief biography will be required. The three candidates with the highest number of votes will fill the three-year term vacancies. The candidate with the fourth highest number of votes will fill the single year term vacancy. The Executive Officers and chair members are then elected and filled by the newly elected board.
